We have 4 concession stations that, when fully staffed, require about 30 volunteers

To prepare and sell our menu requires a staff performing the following jobs:

- Working the window taking orders and money (6 parents)
 - Filling orders (6 people)
 - Making nachos (1 person)
 - Making and selling popcorn, BBQ Sandwiches, Funnel Cakes, and drinks (2-3 parents)
 - Cooking hotdogs, burgers, chicken tenders, cheese sticks fries, and funnel cakes (6 parents)
 - Wrapping hotdogs and burgers (3 people)
 - Running cooked food to concession stand (3 people)
 - Stocking drink coolers (inside stand and popcorn station) (2 people)
 - No special skills required...YOU will be trained

 - Re-rack uniforms at the end of the season (Seniors back into inventory and remaining students to the rising grade level)
